Lyle Lovett

Lyle Lovett is a Grammy Award-winning singer, composer and actor. He has broadened the definition of Americana music in a career that spans 14 albums and more than four million records sold. Coupled with his gift for storytelling, the Texas-based musician fuses elements of country, swing, jazz, folk, gospel and blues in a manner that defies convention and breaks down barriers.

Jonathan Tyler and the Northern Lights

Jonathan Tyler and the Northern Lights was formed in January 2007 in Dallas by members Jonathan Tyler, Brandon Pinckard, Nick Jay, and Jordan Cain, and later joined by Emotion Brown. By 2008, the band was garnering regional and national attention by supporting major national acts including Erykah Badu, The Black Crowes, Chicago, Heart, and Cross Canadian Ragweed. At SXSW 2008, the band was discovered signed. Jonathan Tyler and the Northern Lights tours extensively across the U.S. can be seen at Austin City Limits Music Festival and Summerfest.

Designs by Sean

Designs by Sean is an innovative custom design house led by Trinidad-born Sean De Freitas. Having garnered an unparalleled reputation in the special events industry, Designs by Sean creates a theatrical experience for guests with unique and creative twists. The design house specializes in large-scale costumes.

DJ Lucy Wrubel

The stand-up comedian turned DJ got her start in Rome, Italy, where she found she could overcome the language barrier through music. Dallas-based Lucy Wrubel is an energetic crowd favorite who spins the coolest classics. Her innovative music style brings familiar favorites a fresh new take, and blends beautifully into every event.

Street Corner Symphony

John Martin, Adam Chance, John McLemore, Richie Lister, and Jeremy Liste Street Corner Symphony is a cappella group from Nashville that was runner-up in the second season of NBC's The Sing-Off. The group was founded in 2010 and voices a unique southern soul sound with a rich heritage in gospel music.

Rouse 66: Douglas Rouse

Douglas Rouse is an international artist who excels in anamorphic, or 3-D, chalk drawings. He started as an illustrator for German advertising agencies and quickly morphed into a set painter for music videos and commercial films. Rouse prides himself on being a non-linear thinker, very visual and in touch with his emotions.

Orchestra of New Spain

The Orchestra of New Spain was founded in 1989 by conductor Grover Wilkins as a means of enhancing the place of the landmark Cathedral Santuario de Guadalupe in the heart of the aborning Dallas Arts District. Plans for a concert series there led to his 1985 discovery of the neglected, staggeringly beautiful major musical works of the Spanish 17th and 18th centuries.

Aztec Dancers

The Cuicani In Xochitl is a traditional Aztec dance group based in Oak Cliff at the Ice House Cultural Center. Members participate in a family-oriented tradition, which utilizes motion as a medium to develop spiritual self-awareness. They have been a part of The Office of Cultural Affairs NTP program for the last five years promoting native Mexican cultures.
